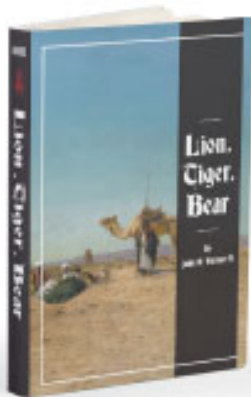


John W. Warner IV Pens Sequel to Acclaimed WWII Historical Novel

WASHINGTON, D.C. (September 15, 2021) -- Growing up in one of America's most respected and historically-significant families — his father is the late Senator John W. Warner III (R-VA), former Secretary of the Navy and Chairman of the Armed Services Committee (KBE); his mother is Catherine Mellon, banking heiress and daughter of philanthropist and highly decorated US Army Major Paul Mellon (OSS, KBE) — John W. Warner IV developed an insatiable quest to discover and disclose hidden truths behind world events. He spent four decades intensely researching military technology history and had extensive conversations with his father, other high-ranking military personnel, and grandfather Paul Mellon to inform his historical novel series.

In ***Lion, Tiger, Bear*** (Amazon Books; \$9.99) the much-anticipated sequel to his debut 3-part historical novel ***Little Anton*** (Amazon Books; \$29.95), Warner cleverly combines primary source material and archival military reports with fictional and satirical elements to create a riveting narrative, revealing the shocking hidden history of super-advanced technology and covert schemes of the German military during the WWII North African campaign, and beyond, into Iraq. Paul Mellon's personal friend and fellow Office of Strategic Services (OSS) psychologist Carl Jung's concept of "synchronicity" is clearly evident and well described in the book's suspenseful narrative—a feast of wartime indelicacies and potent metaphysical concepts.

In ***Lion, Tiger, Bear***, the rash and brash heroine Lady Bea is back and more determined than ever as the irreverent pilot and MI6 operative (British Secret Intelligence Service). Her specialized team's mission is to locate a purported secret German mining operation, airbase, and

Ahnenerbe SS archaeology dig in Iraq that is supplying the German Wunderwaffe's atomic ordinance, free energy, and antigravity programs which rely on mysterious ancient knowledge and materials.

John W. Warner IV, Military Historian, Uncovers Occult Evidence

A dedicated military historian and conspiracy researcher, Warner describes occult (above Top Secret) WWII activity, including the German placement of concrete bunkers, fortifications, and radio towers above underground telluric energy "Ley Lines" to boost their power, and Germany's hidden war weaponry projects, including chemical lasers, atomic weapons, antigravity experiments, and rocket works for Himmler's SS, under the overall auspices of SS General Hans Kammler. Warner also cites evidence regarding the mysterious 1942 "Battle of Los Angeles," and the odd, intelligence-gathering plasma drone "Foo-Fighters" documented in official U.S., British, Russian, and German military files, which caused electrical malfunctions among all combatants' aircraft and ships embroiled in the conflict. Many challenging aspects of the story are true to life, documented, and nearly unbelievable: truth is sometimes stranger than fiction.

Readers will relish the mix of Warner's rich historical details and boundless imagination as he describes scenes such as the genuine 1942 Oval Office meeting between Winston Churchill, General George Marshall, and President Roosevelt, where they devise a global strategy to defeat the powerful Axis forces and try to understand the shocking appearance of UFO-like "Celestial Devices" and "Foo-Fighters" on many battlefronts, their cosmic agendas unknown.

In this unconventional book, the zany duo of Lady Bea Sunderland and her childhood friend Alice Drummond continue their feminist fight for equal status, with Bea first at the helm of a massive German Tiger Tank and then a super-powered airship, while Alice advises, taunts, and navigates. Just as WWII saw women in new roles as mechanics, ferry pilots, intelligence operatives, codebreakers, doctors, nurses, scientists, Warner's books are a celebration of these women and the "Divine Feminine" — the ascendance of women's natural, spiritual and inclusive leadership.

In his Author's Note, Warner shares his disclosure mission born of his family's political history:

"My Grandfather Paul Mellon told me he worked with his boss 'Wild Bill' Donovan on many super-classified aspects of the war, and it is known today that Donovan was intimately familiar with President Franklin Roosevelt's secret UFO File. It is my personal belief arising from my intimate conversations with Paul that he and other OSS officers were there with General Patton when his 3rd Army liberated Pilzen in Czechoslovakia on May 5, 1945; they were great friends, Granddad told me, and he loved serving under the great General. My Granddad has four bronze stars and thousands of classified WW2 documents at the CIA that my Dad and I were unable to acquire through multiple FOIA requests. What is so secret about covert operations that happened seventy-five years ago that cannot be revealed today?"

She taught John to question authority, think independently, and speak his mind. Thanks to his family and his own persistence, Warner has been behind the scenes with some of the most powerful and influential people in US and global history.

When he's not doing research, Warner is also a true "gear head," having spent most of his adult life quenching a thirst for knowledge about race cars—first as a professional Grand Am and American Le Mans Series racing driver (a "middle of the pack man" behind the wheel of a Corvette GT1 and a Porsche GT3R), and later researching the history of the sport for his NASCAR DVD series and his *Little Anton* book series. He started writing during a two-year-long rehabilitation from a racing accident: his long recovery gave him time to go deep into research.
